

## **Double Court Minimus**



## **Purpose**

Double Court naturally progresses from Single Court, both having six blows in fourth place.

New skills include making near/far places in 2-3 whilst hunting between the front and the back.

The six blows in lead allow steady leading to be practised.

The six blows in fourth place provides an opportunity to practise steady covering, whilst watching a pair of bells change below.

## **Ringing Double Court Minimus**

The treble plain hunts.

The working bells make six blows in the lead with the treble leading either side of these. Watching for the treble coming down to the lead will signpost when to leave the front.

Likewise, the six blows at the back in fourth place are made with the treble either side. Watching for the treble will signpost when to leave the back.

When hunting between the back and the front, near/far places in 2-3 are made, with the treble passing in between these places.
