

Single Court Place Minimus



Purpose

Single Court allows ringers to watch for the treble signposts and ring a simple method by the rules, developing ropesight.

As it is only 24 changes long, the work comes round quickly, so it is simple to learn.

Because there are no dodges, it is a good introductory method for ringers who can plain hunt.

Ringing Single Court Minimus

The treble plain hunts.

The working bells plain hunt to thirds place, whenever the treble is below.

If the treble is not below, hunt to the back and make six blows in fourth place (long fourths).

Either side of these long fourths, the treble appears – a signpost to start and finish at the back.
