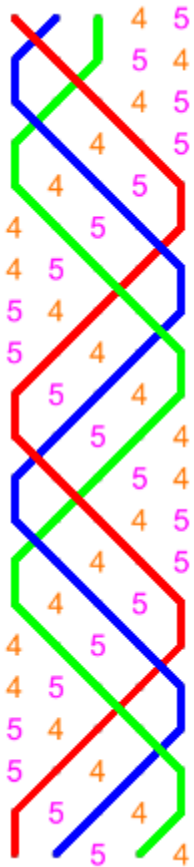


# Flying Dutchman



## Purpose

Flying Dutchman is also known as Churchyard Bob.

It is Plain Hunt with a Grandsire start, and goes round repeatedly without ever coming back into rounds.

Flying Dutchman makes counting places very easy.

## Ringling Flying Dutchman

The treble rings over the bells in the order 2, 3, 4, 5.

The 3, 4 and 5 ring Plain Hunt, starting with a Grandsire start.

Flying Dutchman provides more of a challenge than normal Plain Hunt.

It can be a useful challenge for ringers who have mainly mastered Plain Hunt by following the numbers and need to move on to ringing by counting places.

It can add variety for the tenor ringer as the bells come to the back in a different order than they do with Plain Hunt.
