

## Calling from rounds to Queens

## Purpose

A commonly rung call change on any number of bells, Queens is said to have been given its name after Queen Elizabeth I overheard bells ringing this series of changes and commented how much she liked it.

Queens is a pattern with ascending odd numbered bells, followed by ascending even numbered bells. So, at a 6 bell tower, that would be -135246 or at an 8 bell tower -13572468
